Jeremiah Timm joined Paul Hobbs Wines as Director of Winemaking in 2024. Timm works closely with owner Paul Hobbs to oversee all aspects of the laboratory and cellars, including fermentation, aging, and bottling.

A native of Wisconsin, Timm's wine industry roots run deep, starting in the industry at 17 as a Vineyard and Cellar Worker at Wollersheim Winery in Prairie du Sac. He pursued his Bachelor of Science degree in Enology from Fresno State, continuing to work at Wollersheim Winery during school breaks. Upon graduation, Timm moved out to California.

In 2008, Timm took his first harvest internship at Kosta Browne Winery. He followed that experience with winemaking roles at Moshin, Kosta Browne Winery, and Frank Family Vineyards, before arriving at Browne Family Wines focusing on Cirq and CHEV. In his free time, Timm is an artist, focusing on sketches, paintings, and sculptures, and currently resides in Healdsburg.
